No Orange Processing unit in Amravati district.	 Orange Processing unit should be established in Amravati district under CMEGP scheme. Detailed project report on orange processing units should be made by Krushi Vighyan Kendra (KVK) and Agriculture department. The report should cover the cost of setting up orange processing plant, Land cost and best suited area for establishing the processing unit.
No quality testing labs for textile products and oranges in the district.	testing labs in district and area where to establish the labs should be identified. Feasibility study to be done for the testing labs like demand, cost and benefits.
 Transportation cost from Vidarbha region to JNPT port is very much high. 	This issue is covered in the draft export policy of Maharashtra wherein exporters from Vidarbha and

	transport maximum INR 1 Lakh / unit to MSME exporters.
Import duty on Oranges increased to Rs 63/ kg by Bangladesh Government which needs to be reduced to a certain extent, due to which exports of oranges to Bangladesh in current year has decline drastically.	 For this issue, the state and central government must work together. A DO letter should be sent from the Department of Industries to the Customs department, alerting them to the issue of import duty on oranges levied by Bangladesh government and directing them to take the necessary actions. With the coordination between the Central and State department, this issue may get resolved.
Inland Container Depot (ICD) at Badnera should be developed.	For this issue the Hon'ble collector said the feasibility study should be undertaken and how much imports and exports can be made from the ICD should be estimated. Based on that study ICD at
