

2	Shri Amar Desai asked whether a separate railway rake can be engaged to transport mangoes from Ratnagiri to Mumbai.	Shri.Ravindra Kamble, Regional Manager, KRCL, Ratnagiri informed that mangoes are not available in sufficient quantity to engage a full rake. However, different commodities like cashews, chemicals, polymers, etc. can be accommodated in one rake which will be financially also viable.	KRCL

4	Entrepreneurs present in the meeting expressed that many local industries in this region try to participate in the exhibitions. Stalls are allotted on First Come First Served basis. However, industries / farmers having registration with GI agency, should be given preference in stall allotment. Some stalls should be kept reserved for GI registered industries / farmers. 5	Farmers having Mangonet registration usually send mangoes for export. But expiry date of Mangonet registration is not mentioned on the portal. This creates problem at the clearance stage when port authorities ask for validity of the certificate. Hence while issuing Mangonet registration, validity period should also be mentioned on the portal as well as on the hard copy of the Mangonet registration certificate.	Hon. 6	It is important to ensure that farmer having Mangonet Registration sends mangoes from his own orchid for export. Mangoes from non-registered farmers should not be sent for exports. To ensure this, an OTP facility should be enacted which will stop the misuse of Mangonet certificates. Agriculture department should look into this matter & ensure that mangoes from certified orchids are only sent for exports.	Hon.
