It provides G2B services, one-stop-shop for existing and prospective investors to get consolidated information about the investment process with regards to expanding their existing units or to set up a new business unit in the State. MAITRI has been established with the mandate to provide investor facilitation and to guide the investors in obtaining the required approvals for setting up any unit in the state.

As on date, a total of 119 services spread across 15 departments are accessible through the MAITRI-Single Window System. A meeting was organized under the chairmanship of Hon'ble Additional Development Commissioner (Industries) to review the MAITRI cases.

Towards this end, minutes of the meetings are annexed with this Note.
